

NYC H2O Reading Assignment Reflections

Objectives:

- List important information in the readings assigned by H2O
- Summarize main points in the readings
- Identify details in the reading that support the main points
- Reflect on the reading and how it can be applied to classroom work and reservoir tours

Assignment:

Teachers will write daily reflections on the reading assigned by H2O. The instructor will review the daily reflections based on the rubric below.

Rubric for Reading Assignments

Elements	1 point	2 points	3 points
Lists Important Information	The teacher does not list important information in the reading, or only includes 1 item.	The teacher lists only 2 items of information.	The teacher lists 3 important points of information in the reading.
Summarization	The teacher does not summarize the main points in the reading.	The teacher summarizes some of the main points but the writing is not in the teacher's own words.	The teacher writes 3 or more original sentences that clearly summarize the reading.
Identifies Details That Support the Main Points	The teacher does not identify details that support the main points in the reading.	There is some mention of details but they are inadequate or incomplete.	The teacher identifies details that support the main points in the reading.
Reflection and Relating the Reading to the Teacher's Own Class.	The teacher's written reflection does not show an understanding of how the reading could be applied in the classroom.	The teacher provides a written reflection that shows some understanding of how the reading could be applied in their classroom.	The teacher provides a written reflection on the reading that shows a deeper understanding of how the reading could be applied in the classroom.
